NOTES FROM THE TECHNICAL COMMITTEE

I thought it important to get the word out to the membership, that CARS does have a technical committee. The committee is currently comprised of chairman Mike Kemmett KD8OUE, Vince Bak N8OVW, Eddie Stevens KD8FTS, Mark Moro WJ8WM, and Toby Kolman WT8O.

The primary goal of the this committee is to ensure that CARS technical resources that benefit all the members are working in a reliable manner, as well as updating them, when necessary to keep up with the ever changing capabilities in ham radio. Another goal of the technical committee is providing services to every member of CARS that may need assistance with, any ham radio related, technical issues. In order to accomplish THAT goal, the participation of more members is required. So...anyone interested in participating on the technical committee, please speak with one of the above listed committee members. Additionally, we would like to hear about any concerns you would like assistance with. We are particularly interested in helping new hams get on the air!

The first issue that the committee has taken on is improving our repeater system. The committee is currently working on the purchase, and installation, of new Yaesu DR-1X Dual Band Analog/Digital repeaters. We were able to take advantage of the special pricing offered by Yaesu to amateur radio clubs. Our goal is to make a repeater 'system', that not only increases the area of coverage, but also allows for the use of analog radios, the Yaesu digital radios, EchoLink, and perhaps other VoIP solutions. This will be a time consuming endeavor, as we want to make certain that the final product is one that not only functions as intended, but is reliable, and will benefit our membership, as well as the entire local amateur radio community.

We have currently received two of these new repeaters, with a third one on back order. The first of these new repeaters will be installed at a site in Shaker Hts. The installation of the repeater in Shaker Hts will expand our system coverage further to the east. This installation is scheduled for the 23rd of April.

The second repeater is slated for installation at a site in Brunswick, which will expand our system coverage further to the south. Installation at the Brunswick site is pending, until the completion of tower work that is to be performed by the entity that owns the tower. We're hoping this will be accomplished in the very near future.

When we receive the third repeater, that will be used to replace the existing repeater at the Parma site.

The initial configuration of the three repeater system will be analog only. We are currently researching ways to implement the Analog/Digital configuration system wide, and hopefully can find a cost effective solution in the near future.

I will publish monthly updates in the W.O. as well as give any current updates that may occur, during the weekly Wednesday Net.

The tax situation of the Wampers with respect to HARA is especially interesting, in that they are in considerable arrears; and suggests, unsurprisingly to me, that cash flow is a challenge. What effect any of this might have on Hamvention is also speculative but interesting.
